The Dental Care Program is designed to assist those who are at least 55, are income eligible and who have no insurance or other methods with which to pay for needed dental work. Applicants must be experiencing current dental pain and/or have difficulty eating/chewing, or the applicant must have missing/broken and/or decayed front teeth. Approved applicants are given a voucher to take to a dentist of their choice who practices within the state of Illinois. Assistance is limited to no more than \$1000 per person. The dentist must be willing to accept the voucher and to bill MCHA for the service. Applicants must be current McHenry County residents. Household income must be at or below 50% of the Area's Median Income for the past 90 days. Program availability depends on funding availability.

The following documents are required for Dental Care Program applications:

- Illinois State-Issued Driver's License or Photo ID (required only for adult applicants)
- Proof of current McHenry County residency
- Social Security cards or written verification of Social Security numbers from the Social Security Administration for all household members.
- All documentation of gross income (before taxes and other deductions) for all household members for all of the entire past 90 days. (This includes wages from employment, income from "cash jobs," TANF, Social Security, SSI, insurance compensation, unemployment compensation, child support, disability payments, pensions, etc.).
- Current bank statement (checking and savings, if applicable)
- Proof of receiving assistance from other sources within the past 90 days such as: Medicaid card, Medicare Card, Link card, and/or WIC coupon book (if applicable). Also if applicable, the applicant will need letters from agencies, organizations, family and/or friends listing the type of help and/or the amount of money given. Letters must be verifiable and must contain the name, address and phone number (if any) of the letter writer; and must be signed and dated by the letter writer.
